Official cancellation of the Sand ski European Championship - Fischer Ski Cup 2020

Dear racers,
dear sports fans,

as you all know, the outbreak of the corona pandemic at the end of February this year has changed our lives and habits significantly. Restrictions in public life almost led to a standstill. With the number of infections declining in June, far-reaching easing measures were announced at both European and national levels. Nevertheless, there are still regulations in connection with Covid-19 for events and competitions in Germany and especially in Bavaria that severely restrict a competition like this.

Our European Sand ski Championship not only lives from a purely sporty setting, but also from the flair and atmosphere at Monte Kaolino. The latter cannot be guaranteed this year due to the enormous requirements that have to be met. In addition, some infrastructure, such as a campsite, as overnight stays with tents are still prohibited, is not possible, which is crucial for many of our athletes. An initial request from athletes as to whether we should hold the event met with varying levels of response, from enthusiasm to understanding about a cancellation.

An international event without or with only a few athletes makes no sense with permission. That is why the organizing committee has decided **to officially cancel the European Sand ski Championship**, which should have taken place on July 18 and 19, 2020 at Monte Kaolino in Hirschau.

We hope for your understanding and hope that we can hold the event again next year under regular conditions, a large international field of participants and a large crowd of our fans. Until then, we wish you a successful winter season and see you again next year.
